

Public Water Supply District No. 5 of Greene County

Minutes of The Meeting of The Board of Directors

August 10, 2026

The members of the Board of Directors met at 7:00 pm at the Water Supply office at 113 S. Orchard for the regular monthly meeting of the board. Members present were: President Maurice Butler, Vice President Colt Johnson. Directors, Jeff Adams, Miles Hartley and Willie Choate. Also, present were Treasurer Mark Bennett, Clerk Heidi Edwards and Water Superintendent Leon Burrell. After declaring a quorum, Butler called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.

The minutes of the last meeting were made available to the board members before the meeting. Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Adams seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.

Bennett presented the treasurer's report. Hartley made a motion to approve the treasurer's report as presented. Adams seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.

Heidi reported we have a bulk water customer that got 1,500 gallons from us back on February 25th. She stated she has called and left the owner voicemails but has not gotten a response. He has also been getting a bill mailed each month. The board suggested she mail a demand letter and send a copy to the Christian County Prosecutor. Hartley stated he may go to the business.

Burrell reported that he looked around the office and did not find where the squirrels and birds are getting in. The board said to call a pest control company.

Loss ratio for July was 13%.

Burrell reported that the sidewalk the city is putting in on South Main is going to have a drain culvert under the sidewalk. He stated the contractor and the city will have to lower the stub lines. He talked to the contractor and they will call him when they are back in town. Our water line is going to be in the middle of their culvert, crossing the culvert, not running parallel to the culvert. The city is going to have to raise the drain culvert so that it is higher than our water line.

Butler asked how the leak locator was coming along. Burrell stated they think there is a lot of little leaks up by where Time Travel used to be. Johnson stated that is some of the oldest water lines in town.

Burrell reported he called LaFollette Excavating regarding the project on Old Mill Road. They said the boring company is waiting on the sleeve to come in. He also reminded them about a couple clean ups they need to do. There was discussion about how to cover up the water line by the school soccer field that had a leak. Hartley stated to get bigger rock.

Burrell reported that he has more meters ordered and he has changed out the meters that were not working. He stated the new meters seemed to be working.

Heidi reported that Thompson Gas was out last Wednesday and got their tank put in. She stated that she called MS Propane to let them know we would no longer be using them.

Burrell reported that the adjustor with the insurance company was here last Wednesday to inspect the hail damage.

Hartley asked about the mold on the tower at well 3. Burrell reported it was inspected and will be a couple more years before it gets inspected again. There was discussion about what it would cost to have it cleaned.

Johnson made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Adams seconded. All members voted yes. Motion passed.

Hearing no further business, Hartley made a motion to adjourn. Johnson seconded. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned.
